

Non-insured Services

Non-insured services are those not covered by Medical Services Insurance (MSI). You may have to pay your doctor directly for some of these services. Examples include:

Completion of forms

Medical examinations required for licenses or the completion of documents

Medical advice or prescriptions over the telephone

Medical supplies

Missed appointments
(at least 24 hours notice is required for all cancellations)

Transfer of medical records

Photocopies

Long distance telephone and fax charges

Removal of most non-cancerous skin lesions and warts

Removal of wax from ear

Eye examinations and refractions
(for persons 10-64 years of age)

Before you receive a service that is non-insured, your doctor or the office staff will always discuss the cost of this service with you. You will never be denied care because you are unable to pay, so please let your doctor know if you have a concern.



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
