# BURSARY PROGRAM

Doctors Nova Scotia believes in supporting the educational goals of future physicians. In keeping with this commitment, Doctors Nova Scotia established a bursary for medical students attending Dalhousie University in Nova Scotia and Université de Sherbrooke in Québec.



## MISSION STATEMENT

To maintain the integrity and honour of the medical profession, to represent all members equitably, and to promote high quality health care and disease prevention in Nova Scotia.

## Eligibility

To be eligible, candidates must:

- Be a member of Doctors Nova Scotia
- Be enrolled at Dalhousie University Medical School
- Be a volunteer on a committee or working group, *or* volunteer for an organization, coalition, or government program which falls within health-related fields
- Be a resident of Nova Scotia as defined by the Canada Revenue Agency
- Provide permission to Dalhousie Financial Assistance to share your financial information with Doctors Nova Scotia

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## Award

**Medical students selected can receive up to \$5,000** through Doctors Nova Scotia sponsored bursaries. Students may apply and receive a bursary for each year of medical school.

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## Process

The application must be completed and submitted to Dalhousie University, Dean's Office **by Sept. 30, 2018**. Doctors Nova Scotia will notify recipients and will award the bursaries.
