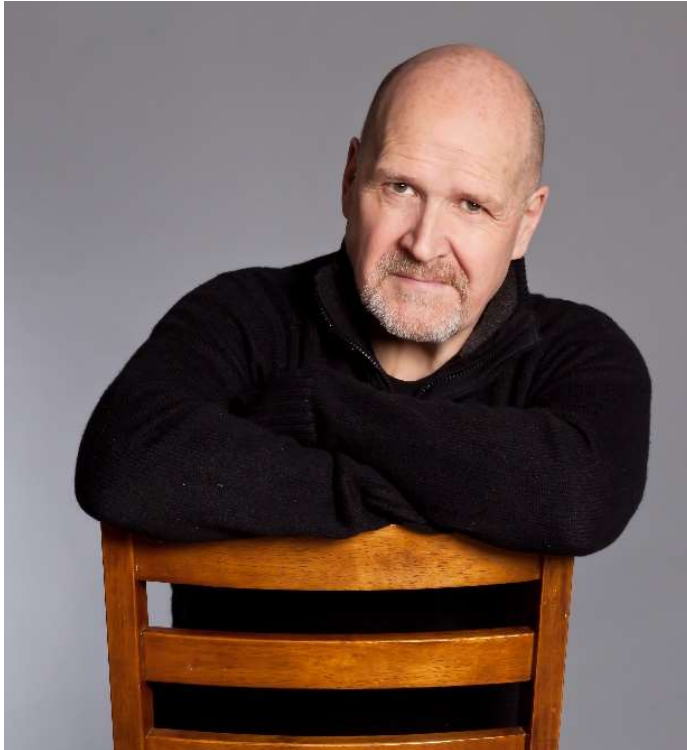


Bill Carr- Host & Emcee Doctors Nova Scotia Achievement Awards

Recently, Bill was cohost of "Shift for Brains" on the Sheldon Macleod Show on News 95.7FM Halifax.

Bill is an active volunteer in his community. He is an honorary Trustee of the IWK Health Centre and appears annually on the IWK Children's Hospital Telethon in partnership with CTV Atlantic.
